

EASTER BIBLE CONFERENCE 2026 REPORT

On the 4th – 6th April 2026, UBF Nigeria held her Easter Bible Conference for the Year 2026, at Redemption City, Lagos-Ibadan Expressway, Nigeria. The Conference which was themed, *'The Vision (Isaiah 6:8)'* attended by about 186 participants (38 children inclusive) from Five Chapters, namely; Lagos Chapter One, Lagos Chapter Two, Medilag Chapter, YabaTech Chapter and UNICAL Chapter. This Conference marked the launch of our newly developed 'UBF Nigeria' Mobile Application, available both on [Android](#) and [IOS](#) Mobile App Stores.

The program began with the Opening Message in John 15:1-15, titled, *'Get up and Walk'* by Bro. Abel Ahamisi (Lagos Chapter One) where we were admonished on the love of Jesus to us even in our helpless and invalid state.
