- 6. For the church in Smyrna, how is Jesus described? (8) How had this church suffered? (9) What direction did Jesus give them? (10) Why did not take away their suffering? What did he encourage them to do? What promise did he give? (10b-11)
- 7. For the church in Pergamum, how is Jesus described differently? (12) How is the spiritual environment in Pergamum described? (13-15) What should the church do? (15-16) What promise is given to those who overcome? (17)
