

The 4 license types that most all chapter will need.

1. Church Copyright License
Every UBF ministry needs this.
2. Streaming or Broadcast License
If you ministry does anything online you need this.
3. Performance License
If your ministry ever preforms music, drams, dance or other type of performance outside of your regular place of worship such as on campus or at a conference – you need this.
4. Church Video License
If your ministry ever shows a video, or video clip during a message or has a movie night, or if your CBF, HBF or Student ministries ever watch a movie together – you need this.
